In all cases your birth must have been registered in Scotland or there must be an entry for you in Scotland in the Adopted Children Register, the Parental Order Register or the Gender Recognition Register.

When Can this Application Form be Used?

This application can be used for a forename and/or a surname change for a person over 16 years of age.

If a change of forename AND surname or a change of surname only is required before age 16, a Form 21 or Form 23 should be completed instead.

Completion of the Form

Note - Any reference to forenames in this application also includes any middle names.

Questions 1-7 - Should be completed as they currently appear on your birth entry. For an individual who is the subject of an Adoption, Parental Order or Gender Recognition the forename(s) and surname(s) and parental details should reflect the names currently recorded in the adoption, parental order or gender recognition register.

Question 8 - For forename(s) changes (first & middle names) (if applicable) please print clearly the new forename(s), defining upper, lower case and accented characters.

Question 9 - For surname(s) changes (if applicable) please print clearly the new surname(s), defining upper, lower case and accented characters.

Fees Pavable

We will confirm by email when the change of name has been recorded.

Limitations

An application for a change of forename and/or surname will be refused if

- i. the application is for a change of forename(s) and a change of forename has already been recorded for you since you attained the age of 16.
- ii. the application is for a change of surname(s) and you have had a change of surname(s) recorded during the previous 5 years, or if you have already had 3 changes of surname(s) recorded.
