Eighteen hundred and eleven Made and given up by Andrew Meikle Millwright at  
Houston Mill in the County of Haddington and Marion Meikle residing there Children  
and only Executors Dative qua nearest of kin Decerned to the said Defunct and that  
by Decreet of the Commissaries of Edinburgh dated the Seventeenth day of  
September Eighteen hundred and thirteen years in itself bears Follows the Inventory  
In the first the said Umquhill Andrew Meikle had pertaining and belonging to him at  
the time of his death five pounds Sterling part of a Legacy of One hundred and fifty  
pounds Sterling bequeathed to the defunct by James Mirrylus late tenant at Upper  
Botton thereafter Residing at Fisherrow conform to Deed of Settlement dated the  
twenty ninth day of September Eighteen hundred and ten Extending said sum of five  
pounds Sterling in Scots money to Sixty pounds [p.463] Summa of the Inventory} lx
