

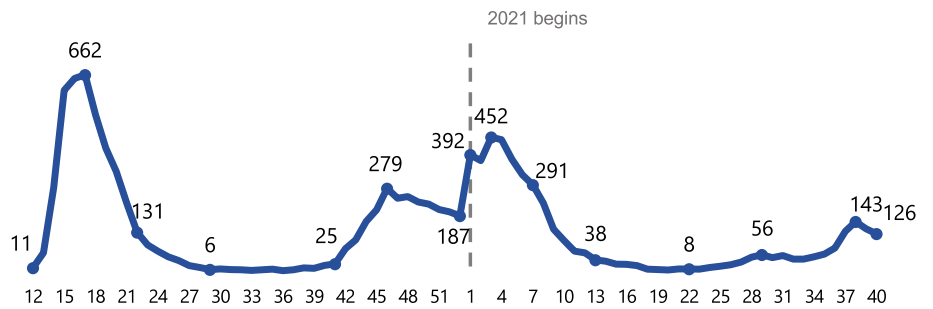
Deaths involving coronavirus (COVID-19): Summary

Excess deaths have been slightly above average in recent weeks

As of 10th October 2021, 11,262 deaths involving Covid-19 have been registered.

Between week 33 and week 38, deaths involving Covid-19 were increasing, however the numbers have fallen in the last two weeks

Deaths involving Covid-19



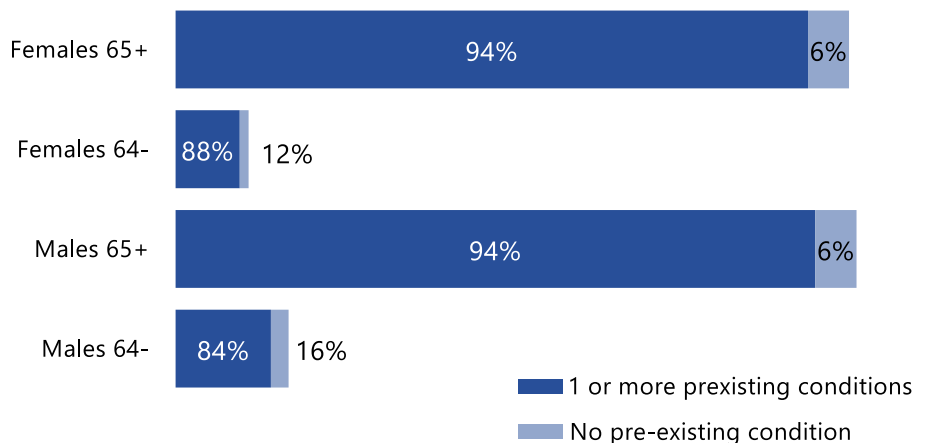
The percentage of deaths involving Covid-19 with no pre-existing conditions is greater in under 65s.

In the 65+ age group 6% of deaths involving Covid-19 had no pre-existing conditions in both males and females

In the under 65s 12% of female deaths and 16% of male deaths had no pre-existing conditions

Pre-existing conditions of deaths involving Covid-19

March 2020 to September 2021



Excess deaths have been above average for 20 consecutive weeks

As of 10th October, deaths are 30% higher than average in 2021. There were 315 excess deaths registered in week 36.

This is the highest weekly percentage excess since week 1 of 2021.
