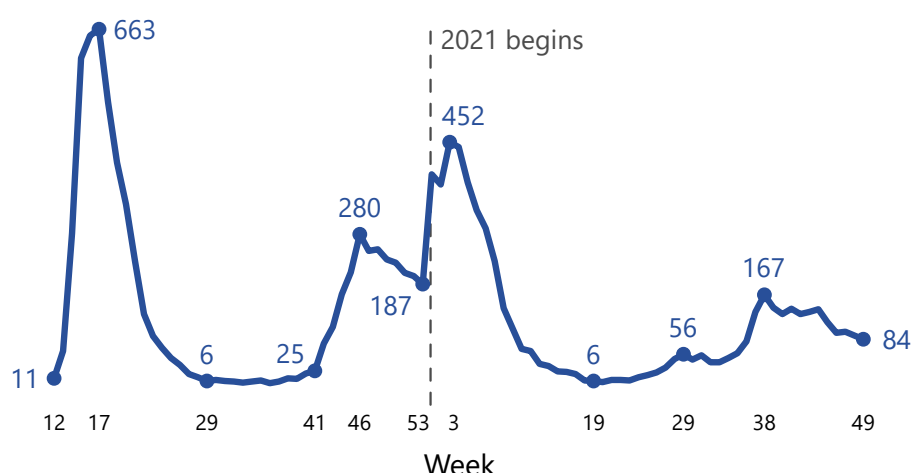


There have been 12,303 deaths involving COVID-19 since March 2020

Deaths involving COVID-19 rose between June and September 2021, reaching 167 deaths involving COVID-19 in week 38.

However, since then the numbers have been falling.

Deaths involving Covid-19 per week

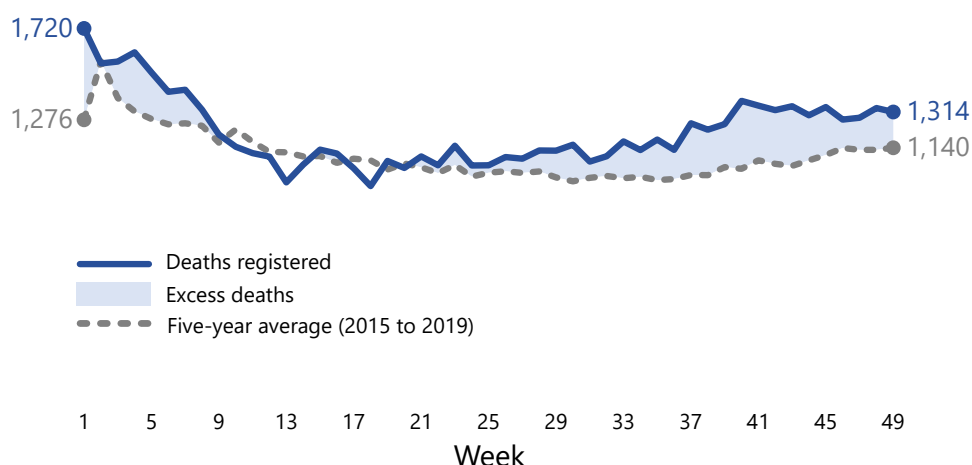


Deaths have been above average for 29 consecutive weeks

There were 174 excess deaths registered in week 49, which is 15% above pre-pandemic average levels for week 49).

In 2021, excess deaths peaked in week 1 at 35% above average.

Most COVID-19 deaths in recent weeks have been in hospitals

Since week 24 deaths in hospitals began to rise peaking in week 38 at 125 deaths involving COVID-19.

This remained fairly constant until week 44 and the numbers have begun to fall since then.
