

Correction to 2012 Household Projections for Scotland's Strategic Development Plan (SDP) Areas

A correction has been made to the 2012-based household projections for SESplan and TAYplan SDP areas. Only the projections for SESplan and TAYplan are affected. This correction has not had any impact on the household projections for Scotland, or for council areas.

A slight error was discovered in one of the Excel workbooks involved in calculating figures used to constrain the projections. The result of this error was that the 2013 household estimate figures used to constrain the projection in 2013 were wrong. These figures are also used to calculate percentage adjustments which are applied to the total numbers of households from 2014 to 2037, therefore these percentage adjustments were also incorrect.

The impact of the error is relatively small. Outlined below is the effect on some key figures from the projections:

SESPlan

- The corrected total household figure for SESplan ranges from being 385 households higher than the originally published figure for 2013 to 432 households higher for 2037. This is an increase of 0.06-0.07 per cent compared with the figures originally published.
- Average household size figures are only different for 3 out of the 25 years of the projection period and the difference is not larger than 0.01 per cent.

TayPlan

- The corrected total household figure for TAYplan ranges from being 385 households lower than the originally published figure for 2013 to 436 households lower for 2037. This is a reduction of 0.17-0.18 per cent compared with the figures originally published.
- Average household size figures are only different for 9 out of the 25 years of the projection period and the difference is not larger than 0.01 per cent.

SESPlan and TayPlan

- The error was in the figures used to constrain the projections, rather than in the projections themselves. Therefore, although there are some small differences in the numbers of households in household type and age group of head of household categories, the percentages of households falling into these categories remain the same as originally published.
- The percentage of people living alone in each year of the projection period by their age group differs by one percentage point at most and not all age groups/years are affected.

The figures for each council area within SESPlan and TayPlan (which were published separately in July 2014) are unaffected. It is only SDP figures which were affected.

The points outlined above relate to the principal projection. This error will also affect the high and low migration variant projections. However, its impact will be similar to that described above.
