

The question on size of workplace was asked for both those in employment in the week before the Census ('workers') and those not so employed but with previous employment ('ex-workers'). An automatic edit was carried out on this variable: if the person was self-employed or freelance without employees (P26), then size of workplace was set to '1 to 9'. Information is not readily available on whether the form-filler had already provided this value. This process was performed for 1.8 percent of workers (6.4 percent of those in workplaces with less than 10 workers) and 1.2 percent of ex-workers (4.3 percent of those in the smallest size of workplace).

A missing value was imputed for 6.1 percent of workers with pretty much the same rate across all categories of size of workplace. The corresponding figure for ex-workers was 15.6 percent - again with little variation by size of workplace.

The ONC process added 3.8 percent of workers with similar rates in most categories of workplace except for the largest size (500 or more) where the percentage was 4.5 percent. Conversely the largest size of workplace saw the lowest rate of person imputation among ex-workers with 3.2 percent compared with an average for ex-workers of 3.6 percent.
